

Dynamic Risk Assessment: STABLE-2007 and ACUTE-2007 Training

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Data from the Dynamic Supervision Project (Hanson, Harris, Scott, & Helmus, 2007) suggests that dynamic prediction tools are capable of extending the predictive validity of risk assessments beyond static, actuarial assessments alone. Participants will receive training in administering and scoring the STABLE-2007 and the ACUTE-2007. Detailed knowledge of a static risk assessment (STATIC-99, STATIC-2002, MATRIX-2000, RRASOR etc.) is assumed and static risk assessment will not be covered. Combining a static risk assessment with STABLE-2007/ACUTE-2007 scorings to complete a full three-level risk assessment will be demonstrated and practiced. This workshop is appropriate for all who assess and manage risk, plan treatment and supervision for community-based sexual offenders.
