

**Children with Sexual Behavior Problems:
Current Findings and Implications for Practice**

This workshop will provide an overview of the current research on sexual behavior problems in children, including typical sexual development and identification of SBP, factors contributing to the development and maintenance of SBP, as well as research based guidelines for identifying SBP. Children with SBP are heterogeneous and distinct from adolescent and adult sexual offenders. Research on typology and long term outcome will be discussed. The latest treatment outcome research, including a recently published meta-analysis, will be presented to facilitate clinical decision making and planning. An overview of the practice components found in efficacious treatments will be provided.
