

**Treatment Soup:
Blending Assessment, Treatment Planning & Interventions**

Working with sexually abusive youth involves starting with an adequate evaluation, developing a treatment plan that addresses the youth's risk/needs, and utilizing treatment approaches and interventions that are responsivity sensitive. Our efforts need to take into consideration the research related to the sexually abusive youth and the juvenile delinquency literature. Part of this workshop will focus on how to turn evaluation results into effective treatment plans that are based on what we know about this specialized population. In addition time will be devoted to identifying and developing interventions congruent with the treatment plan that are both creative and responsivity sensitive.
